That Ontario's Big City Mayors call on the provincial and federal governments to provide continued support to municipalities throughout the 2022 fiscal year to help the province recover from the impacts of COVID-19 and stimulate our local economies. The continuation of the Safe Restart Agreement is essential to keep municipalities whole. Municipalities have been at the forefront of supporting local communities throughout the crisis and municipal services are key to economic growth. It is imperative that municipalities across Ontario continue to receive federal and provincial funding to cover the significant additional costs and loss of revenues.
